## Your responsibilities as Parent/Carer

**As you are attending** with your child, you are responsible for their safety.

**Please do take this wonderful opportunity** to spend time playing with your child and helping them to do crafts and use the equipment in order to support their all round development. It is exciting to see children flourishing as they develop social, emotional, physical and language skills.

**There are First Aid Boxes** behind the reception desk and in the kitchen for emergencies/injuries. If you are in need of any help, then please ask one of our volunteers. We complete an accident form for any accidents requiring First Aid.

**Could you please** be particularly careful that tea and coffee is out of reach of young children? Do not place empty cups on the radiator grills. Thermal mugs are available for those who wish to use them.

**Most young children** will at some stage display undesirable behaviour such as hitting, biting and throwing toys. It is your responsibility to intervene gently and show your child that this is not acceptable. This will help teach the children appropriate boundaries of behaviour and also ensure that Littlefoot is a safe and happy place for them to enjoy. Please feel free to let us know if your child has had a particularly difficult morning.

**We have an excellent reputation** as a very friendly group. If you see someone looking lonely, please do chat to them. You may make a lifelong friend!

**Please also feel free** to help to tidy up, tell us if toys are broken or need cleaning and offer to help prepare a craft activity during the week. And please remember that any and all feedback is valued!

## Buggy Park and Car Parking

**If you come on foot** with a Buggy, we ask you to leave it safely in our buggy park to the right of the main doors.

**You will need to** have your rain covers with you, just in case. We cannot safely accommodate Buggies inside.

**If you come by car**, please park in St Ann's Lane or in Tudor Rd, Earning Street or Park Lane.

**Please do not** park in East Chadley Lane. Please also ensure you are parked safely and courteously so that emergency services can get through and our neighbours are not inconvenienced
