

This app allows you to daily access Morning, Evening and Night Prayer for yesterday, today and a month ahead and includes Bible readings, psalms, canticles, and seasonal variations.

It allows you to: switch between Contemporary and Traditional formats with one click; find details of Feast Days, Festivals and Commemorations from the Common Worship Calendar; read Bible passages in full (NRSV translation) without the need for a separate Bible app.



The Bible in One Year is a daily Bible reading plan which takes you through the whole Bible in 365 days.

It is ideal for anyone who is looking for an easy and accessible way to read and understand the Bible.

You can follow along by reading the text or listening to the audio commentary and you can choose the version that best suits your lifestyle; the Classic version (25 minutes), or a shorter Express or Youth version (both around 15 minutes).

RADIO STATIONS FOR THOSE WHO LIKE TO LISTEN



If you want a mix between Christian and secular content, then this radio station has the best of both worlds. Its mixed format is for those who would not normally want to listen to a deeply themed Christian radio station. It has good resources online for recent Christians to build and strengthen their faith. Listen via the website or an app which can be downloaded.



This radio station is broadcast in the Northeast of England but is available on DAB radio or its website all over the world. The programmes have Christian values and there is a varied choice with the predominant content being music.
