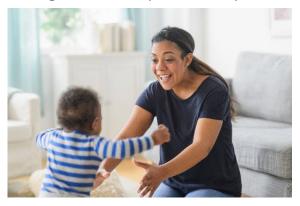
## "THE GOD WHO CHALLENGES AND ENCOURAGES"

Challenges can help us learn to trust God. As we trust God more, our faith in Him becomes steadfast.

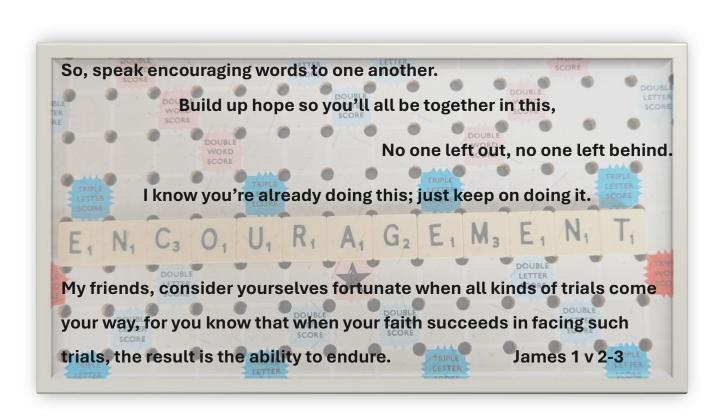
Challenges can help us to develop perseverance. As we persevere our faith in God grows stronger and we become more resilient.

- 4. **Take care of yourself.** Make sure you're getting enough sleep, eating healthy foods, and exercising regularly. When you take care of yourself, you're better able to cope with challenges.
- 5. **Remember that you're not alone.** There are other people who are going through challenges too. Remember that you're not alone and that there is support available to you.

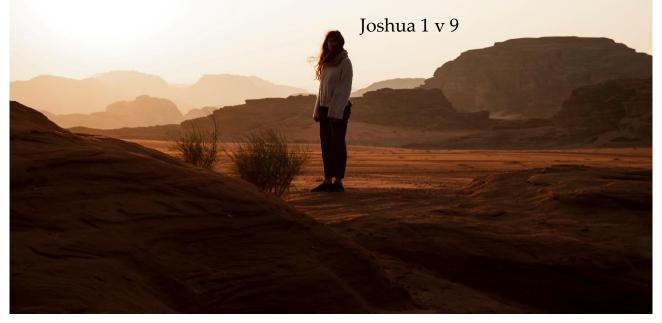
I pray for others who are suffering, and I ask that you give them strength and hope. I pray that you would use their challenges to draw them closer to you and to help them grow in their faith.

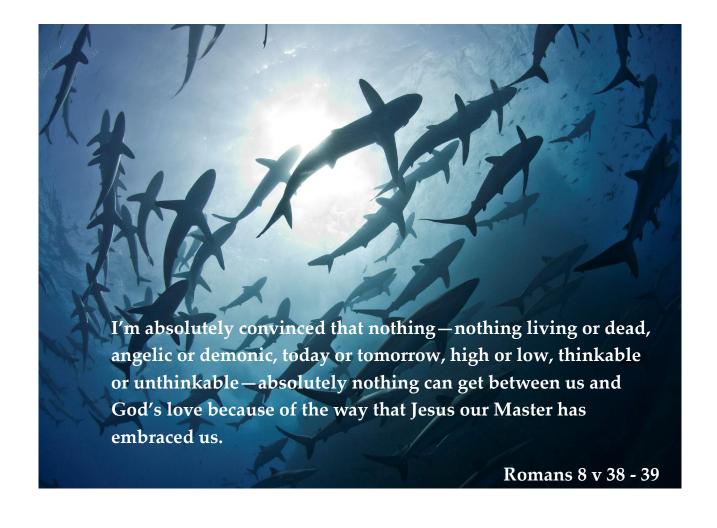

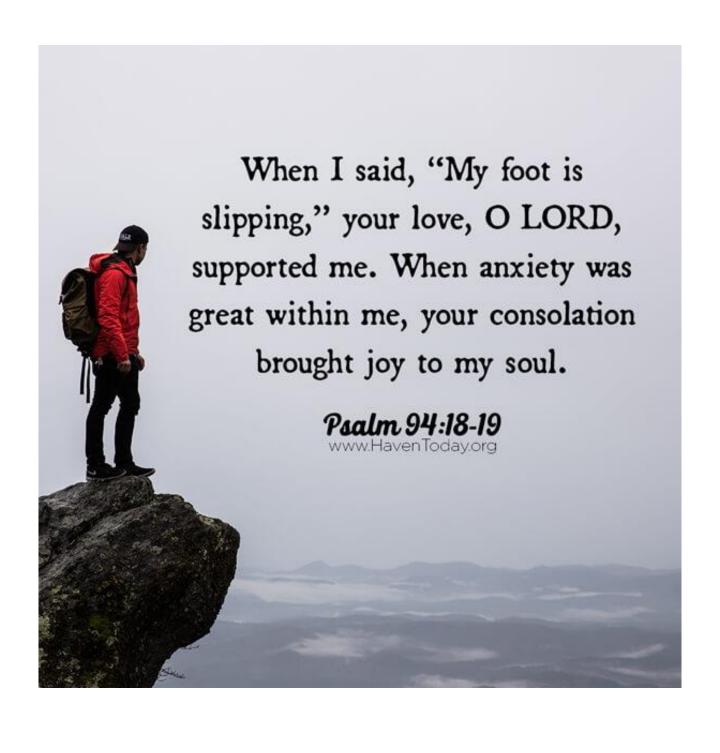


Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous.

God knows what you've been through. He knows how you feel. He knows what you need. He doesn't gloss over what's happened. He doesn't sugarcoat your crisis or the problems you're going through. He simply says, "Be strong, for I am with you."

This is the secret to encouragement. When you feel alone, when you experience doubt, when you are struggling to trust, hear the voice of the Lord saying, "I am with you. Be strong, be courageous, for I will surround you on all sides. I promise that I will be your strong tower in the day of battle. In the world you will have trouble, but take heart, I have overcome the world."
